We cannot see having received an answer to our letter, and would kindly request your firm to return to us with responses to our questions.

We also now see that your subsidiary in Mexico is about to receive yet another shipment from occupied Western Sahara, on Panamanian flagged vessel 'Leo Advance' (IMO number 9442225), due to arrive in Coatzacoalcos on 10 December.

In addition to the 3 questions in the previous letter, we thus hope you are able to respond to these three questions:

- 3) How many tonnes of phosphates did your Mexican subsidiary import from Western Sahara in 2011?
- 4) Has Innophos entered into a new agreement with OCP since the previous agreement expired?
- 5) When does the current agreement expire?
