## THE CRANS MONTANA FORUM

The Crans Montana Forum works to build a more Humane and Impartial World "*Committed to a more Humane and Impartial World*" and encourages international cooperation and overall growth. The first annual **Crans Montana Forum**, in 1990, was dedicated to political and economic reconstruction in a Europe then open in the aftermath of the Cold War. In 2016, unfortunately, this dimension will return to the agenda, due to an international situation that has only deteriorated.

The yearly **Crans Montana Forum** meeting is a world-renowned and unavoidable event on the agenda of every decision-maker.

The various Forums organized worldwide (Brussels, Geneva, Rabat,
